- 3. Rotating wall cloud**
- 4. Hail of any size**
- 5. Thunderstorm wind gusts over 50 mph**
- 6. Thunderstorm damage**
- 7. Flooding of streams or impassable road conditions**

When you check-in we ask you give your call, name and the location you are reporting from this evening.

Following check-ins I will call you back for any comments or information you may have for the net. Please do not check-in until the previous station has been acknowledged.
