

## **Skywarn/Emergency Net ACTIVATION ONLY - PREAMBLE**

**Note to Net Control Operators** – Please make note of the start time, the end time and the callsigns of each participant.

Also, note the time of ANY National Weather Service “Skywarn Reportable Event.”

**QST,QST,QST...This is (YOUR CALLSIGN) - your net control station for this ACTIVATION of the Polk County area Skywarn and Emergency net. My name is (YOUR NAME).**

**This net has been activated due to: \_\_\_\_\_ (severe weather, etc) in our area.**

**I will now stand by for any emergency or priority traffic...**

**READ National Weather Service Warning (or any other reason for the activation – OEM issued, etc).**

**During severe weather, we ask that you report the following to the net:**

- 1. Tornado or waterspout**
- 2. Funnel cloud**
- 3. Rotating wall cloud**
- 4. Hail of any size**
- 5. Thunderstorm wind gusts over 50 mph**
- 6. Thunderstorm damage**
- 7. Flooding of streams or impassable road conditions**

**When you check-in we ask you give your call sign (phonetically), your name and the location you are reporting from. This is a directed net, which means Please do not check in until the previous station has been acknowledged.**

**I will now check-ins from any stations.**

**NCOs- Remain fluid. If no traffic, ID as Net Control for a Skywarn activation.**

**Read the NWS Warning ~every 15 minutes or so as time allows.**

**I'd like to thank everyone for checking into the net.**

**This is (your call sign), closing the net and returning the repeater back to normal amateur radio operation.**

**This is (YOUR CALLSIGN) out.**
