

**Correction to the minutes:  
MOU: Memorandum of Understanding  
Skywarn class April 18th, 6:30 pm**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Teal.

The MOU (method of understanding) states we agree to furnish manpower and emergency communications in an emergency. Also it states that our members wear the issued badge anytime in the Emergency Management building or manning a station in an emergency. We also need to stay certified with the Nation Weather Service for a Skywarn emergency.

Polk County is having a Det Cog exercise March 16, 8 AM. We will be calling an emergency net, including the fire stations.  
We have a scheduled Skywarn class, 6:30 PM, here at the EOC, put on by the National Weather Service. All members need to take the class and recertify.  
President Teal talked about fundraisers for the club. He asked each member to bring back a suggestion for next month's meeting.  
It was suggested to add 1 hour to the ARES report because of the Skywarn Net, reporting hail in our area.  
Motion to send flowers for the past member, Ira Manire's funeral. Approved  
There was a discussion about the language on HF, mainly on 3843, 3840, and 3850.  
Net control operators were assigned, April-Tom, W5QVK, May-Walter, KG5CMC and June either Mark, KB5RKF or Stash, KC5VWV.
